

## Ethiopia: Glass Company Invests \$28Mln in New Factory

### GODA to invest \$28 million in construction of glass and bottle factory in northern Ethiopia.

Bottle and glass manufacturer GODA on Friday announced signing a deal for the construction of a factory.

The ETB 600 million (\$28 million deal) was agreed with two international companies to build the factory in the city of Adigrat in Tigray State.

The project is expected to provide jobs for more than 400 people.

Italian **Glass Service** will manage the industrial design and construction of the factory, and Chinese Geffer will construct the water system, firefighting and other structures.

"The factory will have a production capacity of 90 tons per day," Salih Mohammed Tahir, GODA Engineering Department head told Anadolu Agency on Friday.

The factory will be built on 390,000 square meters of land. Production should begin two years from now, Tahir said. - Ankara
